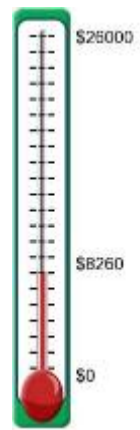

COUNT DOWN TO THE JOG-A-THON:

Pledges & Prizes: To date we have raised approximately \$8,260 towards our \$26,000 school-wide goal. We are in our final week of our Sponsorship drive. The Jog-a-thon is one of our mandatory fundraisers; as such all students are expected to participate and reach their goal of \$100/student (\$200/family). All pledge envelopes are due by Tuesday, October 10th.



Many thanks to those students who have turned in pledge money. The first gift card raffle was held this morning. Students were automatically entered in the raffle with one ticket earned for each \$25 in paid pledges. T-Shirt Day passes were awarded to all students who earned \$50 or more in paid pledges. Starting next week, a second free dress will be handed out for students who have met their \$200 family goal.

Paid pledges should be submitted in the ***Jog-a-thon Collection Envelope*** sent home with each student. Envelopes will be returned for those students who are still working towards their goal. It is very important that these envelopes be returned so that we have an accurate log of the money your student has collected and/or pledged.

Tell your sponsors that pledges may also be paid using **Paypal**. Direct your sponsors to the Jog-a-thon page under the Parent Fundraising tab of the school website (<http://stpatrickschool.org/jogathon.html>) and scroll down to select the *Donate* button. Remember to record the pledge on the ***Jog-a-thon Collection Envelope*** and check the Paypal payment box.

IT'S BOX TOPS SUBMISSION TIME! - Box Tops can be found on many products we use on a daily basis. Products such as Betty Crocker, General Mills, Hanes, Hefty, Nestle, Pillsbury, Ziploc, etc. Each one is worth 10¢ when our school redeems them. While you can turn in box tops at any time, our parent coordinator submits them twice a year, once in October and again in February at which time you will be given 10 cents fundraising credit per box top. Here are a few tips to make the submission process easier.

- Clip the box top neatly and bundle in groups of 10 or 50 using a sealable bag or envelope
- Write your students full name, grade and the number of box tops on the baggie
